DOGS AND CATS

- Age and species-appropriate food
HIGH
- Food and water bowls (stainless steel)
HIGH
- Collar with ID tag
HIGH
- Lead / leash (dogs)
HIGH
- Carrier or crate
HIGH
- Bed or sleeping area
HIGH
- Toys for mental stimulation
HIGH
- Grooming brush (suitable for coat type)
HIGH
- Flea and tick treatment (monthly)
HIGH
- Worming treatment
HIGH
- Pet insurance
HIGH
- Litter tray and cat litter (cats)
HIGH
- Scratching post (cats)
HIGH

- Poo bags (dogs)

HIGH

SMALL ANIMALS (RABBITS, GUINEA PIGS)

- Large enclosure or hutch

HIGH

Must be large enough to do 3-4 full hops

- Hay (unlimited, makes up 80% of diet for rabbits)

HIGH

- Pellets and fresh vegetables

HIGH

- Small animal litter and bedding

HIGH

- Chew toys (for dental health)

HIGH

- Exercise wheel (hamsters and gerbils only)

HIGH

BIRDS

- Bird cage (appropriate size for species)

HIGH

Bigger is always better for bird welfare

- Bird food (species-appropriate seed or pellet mix)

HIGH

- Perches (various sizes and textures)

HIGH

- Bird toys and foraging activities

HIGH

- Cuttlebone (for calcium and beak health)

FISH

- Aquarium or fish tank (correct size for species)

HIGH

- Filter, heater, and air pump

HIGH

Cycle the tank for 2 weeks before adding fish

- Water conditioner and dechlorinator

HIGH

- Fish food (appropriate for species)

HIGH

- Gravel, plants, and decorations

UNIVERSAL ESSENTIALS

- First vet appointment booked

HIGH

All new pets should be seen by a vet within the first week

- Microchipping arranged
