FAMILY COMMUNICATION

- Have open, age-appropriate conversations with children about remarriage
HIGH
- Give children time to adjust: avoid rushing the announcement or ceremony
HIGH
- Notify ex-spouse of remarriage if children are involved (as appropriate)

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

- Confirm your divorce is finalized: obtain divorce decree documents
HIGH
- Check waiting periods: some states/countries require time after divorce
HIGH
- Consult a lawyer about prenuptial agreement options and blended family finances
- Apply for marriage license and include divorce decree if required
HIGH
- Update existing will, estate plan, and beneficiary designations
HIGH
- Review life insurance policies and update beneficiaries

WEDDING PLANNING

- Choose an intimate venue that fits a smaller, more personal second wedding
HIGH

GUEST LIST

- Invite only close family and friends: skip the large formal guest list
- Skip a traditional gift registry: focus on experience gifts or donations

CEREMONY

- Write vows that authentically acknowledge your journey and this new beginning

HIGH

ATTIRE

- Choose understated but meaningful attire (not necessarily white)

CHILDREN'S ROLES

- Decide how to include children in the ceremony (ring bearer, flower girl, readers)

HIGH

- Consider a family unity ceremony (blending sand, unity candle, family vows)
- Plan children's roles in the wedding that feel meaningful, not forced
- Give children a special gift or token on the wedding day

HONEYMOON

- Discuss honeymoon logistics with children: arrange appropriate childcare

HIGH

- Consider a family honeymoon or mini-moon if children are young

RECEPTION

- Plan blended family introduction strategy at reception

PHOTOGRAPHY

- Brief wedding photographer on capturing family and children moments

AFTER WEDDING

- Update name on legal documents post-wedding (if taking new last name)
- Update bank accounts, passport, and social security with new name
- Begin post-wedding blended family routines and bonding activities
